



Dear Governor Graham:

The Florida Pari-Mutuel Commission and the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering respectfully submit their Fifty-fourth Annual Report for the period beginning July 1, 1984 and ending June 30, 1985, in compliance with the requirements of Sections 20.16 (4)(d) and 550.02 (2), Florida Statutes. The Annual Report presents an accurate record of the activities of the Division and the pari-mutuel industry during the fiscal year. The records, files and documents from which the Report is compiled are maintained at the Division offices in the Graham State Office Building, 1350 Northwest 12 Avenue, Room 332, Miami, Florida 33136-2169. These records are open for inspection to all persons during regular business hours.

The Pari-Mutuel Commission has the legislative authority and responsibility for awarding racing dates; hearing appeals of all decisions which relate to the suspension or revocation of a permittee's operating license; making recommendations to the Division regarding new or existing rules for all racing and jai-alai operations; approving all expenditures of the permittee's special capital improvement funds; and issuing an annual report to the Governor and Legislature on the racing and jai-alai industries in Florida. During this period Mr. Stephen Abramson of West Palm Beach continued to serve as chairman of the Florida Pari-Mutuel Commission. Mr. Mack Cleveland, an attorney and former legislator from the Orlando area, was appointed by the Governor to fill the vacancy left by Dr. Leon G. van Wert during the previous year. In May, Mr. Billy Vessels stepped down at the conclusion of his term as President of the National Association of State Racing Commissioners, and was replaced by Dr. M.A. Schofman, a physician from the Miami area. Messrs. James Lewis of Jacksonville and Ted Couch of Tampa continued to serve as members.

The legal battle over the Commission's authority to award the Winter Thoroughbred dates was resolved by the Florida Supreme Court's decision in Gulfstream Park Racing Association, Inc., vs. Department of Business Regulation, Case Nos. 64-186 and 64-257, in which the Court ruled that the Third District Court of Appeals had acted improperly when it ordered the commission to award the dates to Hialeah Park in Hialeah Park vs. Department of Business Regulation. The Commission awarded the 1985-1986 middle dates to Gulfstream Park when Hialeah Park withdrew its application for the Middle Dates. Outside of the authority of the Commission, Hialeah and Gulfstream agreed to give the middle

dates to Gulfstream next year, and to Hialeah Park the following year. It is hoped that this agreement will allow the parties time to resolve the winter thoroughbred dates issue for the foreseeable future.

Also, Commission member Billy Vessels finished out his term as President of the National Association of State Racing Commissioners, and Mr. Abramson was elevated to Vice-President. This year's convention was held in Bal Harbor, Florida, providing an opportunity for racing officials from around the United States and Canada an opportunity to see Florida's pari-mutuel industry first-hand.

The Department underwent a change in leadership this year when the Secretary, Mr. Gary R. Rutledge, resigned in September and was replaced by Mr. Richard B. Burroughs, former Secretary of the Department from 1979 to 1981. The Division wishes to express its gratitude to Secretary Rutledge for his service, and welcomes Secretary Burroughs back to the Department.

Detailed statistical analyses of each of the tracks and frontons which operated during the 1984-85 fiscal year are included in the exhibits of this report.

The industry continued to show healthy signs of growth this year, despite a slight decrease in attendance of .89% to 16,543,816. However, in 5,019 regular performances, \$1,848,680,598 was wagered — an increase of 1%. In addition, 126 charity day performances resulted in a minimum of \$1,026,227.67 being donated to approved charitable organizations (see exhibit L). Chapter 550.164, Florida Statues, requires that abandoned pari-mutuel tickets over one year old from Greyhound and Jai-Alai permitholders should escheat to the State for deposit to the Principal of the State School fund. These funds are used for the support and maintenance of our public schools. A total of \$3,082,638.90 was received from this source by the Division throughout this fiscal year. Chart I shows yearly receipts dating from 1957, when the Division began collecting these funds. Pursuant to Chapter 550.263 (2) Florida Statutes, funds from abandoned tickets for all Thoroughbred, Harness, and Quarter Horse racing events are deposited to their respective Promotional Trust Funds for payments of breeders' and stallions' awards.

Permittees may choose to operate charity days on behalf of the Scholarship Trust Fund, created for the purpose of providing scholarships for qualified applicants. The fund is administered by the State Board of Regents. A total of \$165,961.98 was deposited to the Scholarship Trust Fund in the past fiscal year (See Chart II).

Growth in the pari-mutuel industry in Florida resulted in increases in revenue to the State as well. The sum of \$123,878,295.18 was collected from all sources by the Division this fiscal year. Of this amount, \$4,256,905.51 was expended in regulating the operations of the entire industry. \$29,915,500 was distributed to 67 countries, each county receiving \$446,500.00. Deposits to the General Revenue Fund totaled \$59,495,420.05 to provide substantial support to the varied functions of State Government. Fines from medication rule violations are deposited to the Racing Research Trust Fund. A total of \$13,900.00 was collected during the fiscal year for this purpose.

The Division continued in its efforts to effectively enforce the medication statutes and rules. Towards this end, the Bureau of Laboratory Services performed 174,557 analyses of 53,124 samples resulting in 138 reports of illegal drugs. The positives were then referred to the Division Director for appropriate regulatory and legal action. At the same time, the Bureau utilizes its legislative appropriations and funds from the Racing Research Trust Fund to participate in the National Association of State Racing Commissioners' quality assurance program and certain research from the University of Florida.

In addition to reporting positives, the laboratory informs the Division Director of tracks where multiple suspicious or unidentifiable substances appear in samples. He may then direct the Bureau of Investigations to confirm the existence of illegal substances so that administrative action can be taken. This has proven to be helpful in the control of illegal drugging.

The Bureau of Investigations has also dedicated substantial manpower to license falsification issues in a continuing effort to prevent ineligible applicants from becoming licensed. On a larger scale, the Bureau performed extensive background investigations on individuals who wished to purchase significant interests in pari-mutuel associations.

In conclusion, the Division Director and his staff appreciate the continued support; and cooperation which has been received from members of the Legislature and their staffs. The Division is deeply indebted to Governor Bob Graham for his continued and renewed interest and support of the State's vital pari-mutuel industry. In addition, the Division expresses its thanks to former Secretary Rutledge, Secretary Burroughs and the Commission for their continued support in

the Division's efforts to more capably and fairly regulate the State's pari-mutuel industry.
