FINAL ORDER ON WAIVER

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation ("Department" or "Division"), issues this Final Order against Jonathan Al Pastor ("Respondent") and states as follows:

- 1. An Administrative Complaint was filed in this case on August 7, 2017, alleging a violation of Sections 551.109(3) and 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes (2015).
- 2. The Administrative Complaint, Election of Rights form, an Explanation of Rights, and a cover letter were served via certified mail.
- 3. The Election of Rights and Explanation of Rights informed Respondent that a response to the Complaint, including the request for a hearing, was due within twenty-one (21) days of service of the Administrative Complaint.
- 4. Rule 28-106.111, Florida Administrative Code (2016), provides that Respondent waives the right to a hearing on the complaint if Respondent fails to request a hearing in this matter.
- 5. Petitioner made all reasonable efforts to provide notice to Respondent. Proof of service via certified mail is attached in said Motion for Waiver of Rights and Final Order as

Exhibit "1".

Upon consideration of the motion and the facts and conclusions of law in the Administrative Complaint, it is ordered:

- 6. The allegations of fact as set forth in the Administrative Complaint are approved, adopted, and incorporated herein by reference as findings of fact by the Division.
- 7. The conclusions of law as alleged and set forth in the Administrative Complaint are approved, adopted, and incorporated herein by reference as the conclusions of law by the Division.
- 8. There is competent substantial evidence to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law by the Division.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND AJUDGED:

- Respondent's license is hereby REVOKED.
- 10. Respondent is hereby **EXCLUDED** from all pari-mutuel facilities in the State of Florida.
- 11. This Final Order shall become effective on the date of filing with the Agency Clerk of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation.

MOTION FOR WAIVER OF RIGHTS AND FINAL ORDER

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, ("Petitioner"), moves the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering ("Division") for a finding of Waiver of Rights by Jonathan Al Pastor ("Respondent") and a Final Order. In support thereof, Petitioner states the following:

- 1. An Administrative Complaint was filed in case number 2016-012494 on August 7, 2017, alleging violations of Sections 551.109(3) and 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes (2015). A true copy of the Administrative Complaint is attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference.
- 2. On or about August 14, 2017, Petitioner served Respondent the Administrative Complaint along with an Explanation of Rights and Election of Rights Form via personal service. Proof of service of the complaint is attached as Exhibit "B" and incorporated by reference.
- 3. The Election of Rights and Explanation of Rights informed Respondent that a response to the Complaint, including an election of rights form for return, was due within twenty-one (21) days of service of the Administrative Complaint. Respondent was informed

further that failure to respond to the Administrative Complaint would result in a waiver of Respondent's right to a hearing in this matter.

- 4. To date, Respondent has not filed an Election of Rights form or otherwise established a disputed issue of material fact in response to the Administrative Complaint filed and served in this action. Pursuant to Rule 28-106.111, Florida Administrative Code (2017), if Respondent fails to request a hearing within twenty-one (21) days of receipt of an agency pleading, Respondent shall have waived his right to request a hearing of the facts alleged.
- 5. By failing to file a response within twenty-one (21) days of receipt of the Administrative Complaint, Respondent has waived his right to request a hearing. Therefore, Petitioner submits this matter for final action by the Division pursuant to Section 120.57(2), Florida Statutes (2017).

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully moves the Division to enter a finding of waiver and the entry of a Final Order that imposes such penalties as authorized by Chapter 550, Florida Statutes, and the rules promulgated thereunder.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

STATE OF FLORIDA

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering ("Petitioner"), files this Administrative Complaint against Jonathan Al Pastor ("Respondent"), and alleges as follows:

- 1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating pari-mutuel wagering pursuant to Chapter 550, Florida Statutes.
- 2. At all times material, Respondent held a slot machine "combo" general individual license, number 8560494-1056, issued by the Division.
- 3. At all times material, Respondent was employed as an executive host with Calder Casino, a licensed pari-mutuel wagering facility.
 - 4. On or about January 18, 2016, Respondent altered Players Club Accounts to allow an individual not associated with those accounts to use Players Club cards for free play at Calder Casino's slot machines.
 - 5. On or about March 11, 2016, Respondent was given a lifetime ejection from Calder Casino.

COUNT I

- 6. Petitioner hereby re-alleges and incorporates the allegations contained within paragraphs one through five, as though fully set forth herein.
 - 7. Section 551.109(3), Florida Statutes (2015), states:

Any person who knowingly excludes, or takes any action in an attempt to exclude, anything of value from the deposit, counting, collection, or computation of revenues from slot machine activity, or any person who by trick, sleigh-of-hand performance, a fraud or fraudulent scheme, or device wins or attempts to win, for himself or herself or for another, money or property or a combination thereof or reduces or attempts to reduce a losing wager in connection with slot machine gaming commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

8. Based on the foregoing, Respondent violated Section 551.109(3), Florida Statutes (2015), by attempting to win for himself or for another, money or property or a combination thereof or reducing or attempted to reduce a losing wager in connection with slot machine gaming by trick, fraud or fraudulent scheme, or device.

COUNT II

- 9. Petitioner hereby re-alleges and incorporates the allegations contained within paragraphs one through five, as though fully set forth herein.
- 10. Section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes (2015), states that "[t]he division may exclude from any pari-mutuel facility within this state any person who has been ejected from a pari-mutuel facility in this state..."
- 11. Based on the foregoing, Respondent violated Section 550.0251(6), Florida Stautes (2015), by being ejected from Calder Casino, a pari-mutuel factility.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner requests the Division enter an Order imposing one or more of the penalties specified in Section 550.105, or 849.086(14), Florida Statutes including revocation, suspension, or the imposition of an administrative fine.
