FINAL ORDER

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering (hereinafter "Petitioner"), issues this Final Order against JOSEPH C. BROWN, III (hereinafter "Respondent") as follows:

- 1. An Administrative Complaint was filed in this case on August 22, 2018, alleging that Respondent violated certain provisions of Chapter 550, Florida Statutes. A copy of the Administrative Complaint is attached hereto as Exhibit "1".
- 2. The Administrative Complaint, Election of Rights form, an Explanation of Rights, and a cover letter were served on Respondent via U.S. Certified Mail on August 27, 2018. Proof of service is attached hereto as Exhibit "2".
- 3. The Election of Rights form, Explanation of Rights, and cover letter informed Respondent that a written response to the Administrative Complaint, including the right to request a hearing, was due within 21 days of actual service of the Administrative Complaint. See section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, and rule 28-106.111, Florida Administrative Code.
 - 4. Petitioner made all reasonable efforts to provide actual notice to Respondent.

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5. Petitioner informed Respondent that the failure to file a timely response to the Administrative Complaint shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.

6. Respondent has not filed a timely response to the Administrative Complaint.

Respondent has not submitted any evidence or made any allegations that would support the

application of the doctrine of equitable tolling.

Having considered the Administrative Complaint, the evidence of Petitioner's reasonable

attempts to provide actual notice to Respondent, and being otherwise fully advised in the

premises, it is hereby

ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

7. The allegations of fact and the conclusions of law in the Administrative Complaint

are adopted in their entirety herein.

8. Respondent's PMW Slot Combo Professional License, number 7887611-1055 is

PERMANENTLY REVOKED and Respondent is PERMANENTLY EXCLUDED from all

Florida pari-mutuel facilities.

9. This Final Order is effective on the date it is filed with the Agency Clerk of the

Department of Business and Professional Regulation as indicated on the first page of this Final

Order.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering (Petitioner), files this Administrative Complaint against Joseph C. Brown, III (Respondent), and alleges as follows:

- 1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating pari-mutuel wagering pursuant to Chapter 550, Florida Statues.
- At all times material hereto, Respondent held a PMW Slot Combo Professional 2. License, number 7887611-1055, issued by the Petitioner.
- At all times material hereto, Respondent worked as a vault supervisor at 3. Gulfstream Park.
- Gulfstream Park is a facility operated by a permitholder authorized to conduct 4. pari-mutuel wagering in this state under Chapter 550, Florida Statutes.
- On July 13, 2018, Respondent admitted to his involvement in a scheme to defraud 5. Gulfstream Park by stealing cash and/or other items of value from Gulfstream Park's vault over a period of at least two (2) years.

- 6. As a result of Respondent's fraudulent activities, Gulfstream Park estimates its total loss between \$35,000 \$40,000.
- 7. Respondent has been terminated and permanently excluded from Gulfstream Park.

COUNT I

- 8. Petitioner realleges and incorporates paragraphs numbered one through seven as if set forth fully herein.
 - 9. Rule 61D-11.005(4), Florida Administrative Code, provides that:
 - (4) No person shall, either directly or indirectly:
 - (a) Employ or attempt to employ any device, scheme, or artifice to defraud any participant in a game or the cardroom operator.
 - (b) Engage in any act, practice, or course of operation that would constitute a fraud or deceit upon any participant in a game or the cardroom operator.
 - (c) Engage in any act, practice, or course of operation with the intent of cheating any participant or the cardroom operator.
- 10. Based on the foregoing, Respondent is in violation of Rule 61D-11.005(4), Florida Administrative Code, by participating in a scheme to steal cash and/or other items of value while working as Gulfstream Park's vault supervisor on or about June 21, 2018.

COUNT II

- 11. Petitioner realleges and incorporates paragraphs numbered one through seven as if set forth fully herein.
 - 12. Section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes, provides in relevant part that:
 - In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any pari-mutuel facility in the state, the division may exclude any person from any and all

pari-mutuel facilities in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this chapter or the rules of the division. The division may exclude from any pari-mutuel facility within this state any person who has been ejected from a pari-mutuel facility in this state or who has been excluded from any pari-mutuel facility in another state by the governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over pari-mutuel facilities in such other state.

Based on the foregoing, Respondent is subject to permanent exclusion from all pari-mutuel facilities in the state of Florida by virtue of his permanent exclusion from Gulfstream Park from July, 2018.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Division Director enter an Order imposing against Respondent one or more of the penalties specified in Sections 550.105, 550.0251, Florida Statutes, and/or any other relief that the Division is authorized to impose pursuant to Chapter 550, Florida Statutes, and/or the rules promulgated thereunder.
