FINAL ORDER

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering ("Petitioner" or "Division"), hereby enters this Final Order against Tyronn Marques Turner ("Respondent"), and states as follows:

- 1. An Administrative Complaint was filed in this case on March 11, 2019, alleging that Respondent is subject to discipline under the provisions of section 551.0251(6) Florida Statutes ("Administrative Complaint"). A true and correct copy of the Administrative Complaint is attached hereto as Exhibit "1" and incorporated by reference.
- 2. Service of the Administrative Complaint was attempted via certified mail on Respondent on March 19, 2019 and April 25, 2019. Proofs of attempted service via certified mail is attached hereto as Exhibit "2" and incorporated by reference.
- 3. Notice of this matter was served upon Respondent on July 26, 2019, August 2, 2019, August 9, 2019, and August 16, 2019, via publication in the *Miami Daily Business Review* a publication in general circulation within Miami-Dade County, Florida ("Notice of Action"). A

true and correct copy of the Notice of Action is attached hereto as Exhibit "3" and incorporated by reference.

- 4. The Notice of Action informed Respondent that Petitioner filed an Administrative Complaint against them, provided instructions on how to receive a copy of the Administrative Complaint, and that contact would be required to dispute the allegations within the Administrative Complaint. See § 120.569(1), Fla. Stat. and Fla. Admin. Code R. 28-106.111.
- 5. In addition, the Notice of Action informed Respondent that the failure to timely file a response to the Administrative Complaint would be deemed a waiver of right to a hearing or resolution in this matter.
- 6. To date, Respondent has not submitted an Election of Rights form or otherwise provided a response to the Administrative Complaint filed and served in this action.

Upon Consideration of the facts and conclusions of law delineated in the Administrative Complaint, it is ORDERED:

- 7. The allegations of fact set forth in the Administrative Complaint are approved, adopted and incorporated herein by reference as findings of fact by the Division.
- 8. The conclusions of law alleged and set forth in the Administrative Complaint are approved, adopted, and incorporated herein by references as the conclusions of law by the Division.
- 9. There is competent substantial evidence to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law by the Division.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

10. Respondent is **PERMANENTLY EXCLUDED** from all licensed pari-mutuel

facilities in the State of Florida.

11. This Final Order shall become effective upon its date of filing with the Agency

Clerk of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation.

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ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering ("Petitioner"), files this Administrative Complaint against Tyronn Marques Turner ("Respondent"), and alleges as follows:

- 1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating pari-mutuel wagering and slot machine gaming pursuant to chapters 550 and 551, Florida Statutes.
- 2. At all times material hereto, Respondent's address of record is 2245 North West 46th Street, Miami, Florida 33145.
 - 3. At all times material hereto, Respondent was a patron of Miami Casino, LLC.
- 4. Miami Casino, LLC is a facility operated by a permitholder authorized to conduct pari-mutuel wagering and operate slot machines in this state under chapters 550 and 551, Florida Statutes.
 - 5. On or about July 29, 2018, Respondent was ejected from Miami Casino, LLC.
 - 6. Section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes (2018), provides in relevant part:

In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any parimutuel facility in the state, the division may exclude any person

from any and all pari-mutuel facilities in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this chapter or the rules of the division. The division may exclude from any pari-mutuel facility within this state any person who has been ejected from a pari-mutuel facility in this state or who has been excluded from any pari-mutuel facility in another state by the governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over pari-mutuel facilities in such other state.

Emphasis added.

7. Based on the forgoing, Respondent is subject to exclusion from all pari-mutuel facilities within the state based on his ejection from Miami Casino, LLC on or about July 29, 2018.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Division Director enter an Order permanently excluding Respondent from all licensed pari-mutuel facilities in the state of Florida along with any other remedy provided by chapters 550, 551, Florida Statutes, and/or the rules promulgated thereunder.




