FINAL ORDER

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering (hereinafter "Petitioner"), issues this Final Order against Luis Dominguez, (hereinafter "Respondent") as follows:

- 1. An Administrative Complaint was filed in this case on January 23, 2019 alleging that Respondent violated certain provisions of Chapter 550, Florida Statutes. A copy of the Administrative Complaint is attached hereto as Exhibit "1" and incorporated by reference.
- 2. The Administrative Complaint, Election of Rights form, an Explanation of Rights, and a cover letter were served on Respondent via certified mail on February 7, 2019. Proof of service is attached hereto as Exhibit "2" and incorporated by reference.
- 3. The Election of Rights form, Explanation of Rights, and cover letter informed Respondent that a written response to the Administrative Complaint, including the right to request a hearing, was due within 21 days of actual service of the Administrative Complaint. See section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, and rule 28-106.111, Florida Administrative Code.

4. Petitioner informed Respondent that the failure to file a timely response to the Administrative Complaint shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.

5. Respondent has not filed a timely response to the Administrative Complaint. Respondent has not submitted any evidence or made any allegations that would support the application of the doctrine of equitable tolling.

Having considered the Administrative Complaint, the evidence of Petitioner's reasonable attempts to provide actual notice to Respondent, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is hereby

ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

- 6. The allegations of fact and the conclusions of law in the Administrative Complaint are adopted in their entirety herein.
- 7. Respondent shall be **PERMANENTLY EXCLUDED** from all licensed pari-mutuel facilities in the state of Florida.
- 8. This Final Order is effective on the date it is filed with the Agency Clerk of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation as indicated on the first page of this Final Order.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering ("Petitioner"), files this Administrative Complaint against Luis Dominguez ("Respondent"), and alleges as follows:

- 1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating pari-mutuel wagering pursuant to chapter 550, Florida Statutes.
- 2. At all times material hereto, Respondent held a PMW General Individual Occupational license, number 10647893-1022, issued by the Petitioner.
- 3. At all times material hereto, Palm Meadows Training Center ("PMTC") was a facility authorized to train thoroughbred horses raced at Gulf Stream Park and Calder Race Course, which are both authorized to conduct pari-mutuel wagering in the State of Florida.
- 4. At all times material hereto, Respondent was in an on-site dorm area at PMTC. Within the dorm, Respondent was found by security personnel with drugs, drugs paraphernalia, and two firearms.

- 5. Respondent's actions were in violation of the facility's lessee agreement.
- 6. On or about November 11, 2018, Respondent was ejected and permanently excluded from PMTC.
 - 7. Section 550.0251(6), Florida States, provides in relevant part:

In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any parimutuel facility in the state, the division may exclude any person from any and all pari-mutuel facilities in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this chapter or the rules of the division. The division may exclude from any pari-mutuel facility within this state any person who has been ejected from a pari-mutuel facility in this state or who has been excluded from any pari-mutuel facility in another state by the governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over pari-mutuel facilities in such other state.

(Emphasis supplied).

8. Based on the foregoing, Respondent is subject to permanent exclusion from all licensed pari-mutuel facilities in the State of Florida based on his permanent exclusion from PMTC on November 11, 2018.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Division Director enter an Order permanently excluding Respondent from all licensed pari-mutuel and slot machine facilities in the State of Florida along with any other remedy provided by chapter 550, Florida Statutes, and/or the rules promulgated thereunder.
