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FINAL ORDER

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering (hereinafter "Petitioner"), issues this Final Order against Katrina Ewa Dutton (hereinafter "Respondent") as follows:

- 1. An Administrative Complaint was filed in this case on February 28, 2019, alleging that Respondent violated certain provisions of Chapter 550, Florida Statutes. A copy of the Administrative Complaint is attached hereto as Exhibit "1".
- 2. The Administrative Complaint, Election of Rights form, an Explanation of Rights, and a cover letter were served on Respondent via certified mail on March 2, 2019. Proof of service is attached hereto as Exhibit "2".
- 3. The Election of Rights form, Explanation of Rights, and cover letter informed Respondent that a written response to the Administrative Complaint, including the right to request a hearing, was due within 21 days of actual service of the Administrative Complaint. See section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, and rule 28-106.111, Florida Administrative Code.
 - 4. Petitioner made all reasonable efforts to provide actual notice to Respondent.

5. Petitioner informed Respondent that the failure to file a timely response to the Administrative Complaint shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.

6. Respondent has not filed a timely response to the Administrative Complaint.

Respondent has not submitted any evidence or made any allegations that would support the

application of the doctrine of equitable tolling.

Having considered the Administrative Complaint, the evidence of Petitioner's reasonable

attempts to provide actual notice to Respondent, and being otherwise fully advised in the

premises, it is hereby

ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

7. The allegations of fact and the conclusions of law in the Administrative Complaint

are adopted in their entirety herein.

8. Respondent's PMW Slot Combo Professional License, number 11424323-1055 is

hereby **REVOKED**.

9. Respondent is hereby **PERMANENTLY EXCLUDED** from all licensed pari-mutuel

facilities in the State of Florida.

10. This Final Order is effective on the date it is filed with the Agency Clerk of the

Department of Business and Professional Regulation as indicated on the first page of this Final

Order.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering ("Petitioner"), files this Administrative Complaint against Katrina Ewa Dutton ("Respondent") and alleges:

- 1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating pari-mutuel wagering, slot machines, and cardroom operations pursuant to chapters 550, 551, and section 849.086, Florida Statutes.
- 2. At all times material hereto, Respondent held a PMW Slot Combo Professional License, number 11424323-1055, issued by Petitioner.
- At all times material hereto, the Isle Casino of PPI, Inc. ("PPI") was a facility operated by a permitholder authorized to conduct pari-mutuel wagering and operate slot machines in the state of Florida.
- 4. On or about December 28, 2018, Respondent was ejected and permanently excluded from PPI.

5. Section 551.112, Florida Statutes, provides:

In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any facility of a slot machine licensee in this state, the division may exclude any person from any facility of a slot machine licensee in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this chapter or the rules of the division. The division may exclude from any facility of a slot machine licensee any person who has been ejected from a facility of a slot machine licensee in this state or who has been excluded from any facility of a slot machine licensee or gaming facility in another state by the governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over the gaming in such other state. This section does not abrogate the common law right of a slot machine licensee to exclude a patron absolutely in this state.

(Emphasis supplied).

6. Section 550.0251(6), Florida States, provides in relevant part:

In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any parimutuel facility in the state, the division may exclude any person from any and all pari-mutuel facilities in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this chapter or the rules of the division. The division may exclude from any pari-mutuel facility within this state any person who has been ejected from a pari-mutuel facility in this state or who has been excluded from any pari-mutuel facility in another state by the governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over pari-mutuel facilities in such other state.

(Emphasis supplied).

7. Based on the foregoing, Respondent is subject to permanent exclusion from all licensed pari-mutuel facilities in the state of Florida based on her permanent exclusion from PPI on December 28, 2018.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Division Director enter an Order permanently excluding Respondent from all licensed pari-mutuel and slot machine facilities in

the state of Florida along with any other remedy provided by chapters 550, 551, and 849, Florida Statutes, and/or the rules promulgated thereunder.

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

Pursuant to rule 28-106.111, *Florida Administrative Code*, you must request a hearing within 21 days from receipt of this Notice, or you will waive your right to request a hearing.
