FINAL ORDER

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering (hereinafter "Petitioner"), issues this Final Order against Robert M. Baker (hereinafter "Respondent") as follows:

- An Administrative Complaint was filed in this case on May 31, 2019, alleging 1. that Respondent violated certain provisions of Chapter 550, Florida Statutes. A copy of the Administrative Complaint is attached hereto as Exhibit "1".
- 2. The Administrative Complaint, Election of Rights form, an Explanation of Rights, and a cover letter were served on Respondent via certified mail on June 8, 2019. Proof of service is attached hereto as Exhibit "2".
- 3. The Election of Rights form, Explanation of Rights, and cover letter informed Respondent that a written response to the Administrative Complaint, including the right to request a hearing, was due within 21 days of actual service of the Administrative Complaint. See section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, and rule 28-106.111, Florida Administrative Code.
 - Petitioner made all reasonable efforts to provide actual notice to Respondent. 4.

5. Petitioner informed Respondent that the failure to file a timely response to the Administrative Complaint shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.

6. Respondent has not filed a timely response to the Administrative Complaint. Respondent has not submitted any evidence or made any allegations that would support the application of the doctrine of equitable tolling.

Having considered the Administrative Complaint, the evidence of Petitioner's reasonable attempts to provide actual notice to Respondent, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is hereby

ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

- 7. The allegations of fact and the conclusions of law in the Administrative Complaint are adopted in their entirety herein.
- 8. Respondent is PERMANENTLY EXCLUDED from all pari-mutuel facilities in the State of Florida.
- 9. This Final Order is effective on the date it is filed with the Agency Clerk of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation as indicated on the first page of this Final Order.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering ("Petitioner"), files this Administrative Complaint against Robert M. Baker ("Respondent") and alleges:

- 1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating pari-mutuel wagering and cardroom operations pursuant to chapter 550 and section 849.086, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent's address is reported as 20822 Northwest 24th Court, Miami Gardens, Florida 33056.
- 3. At all times material hereto, Respondent was a patron of 831 Federal Highway Acquisition, LLC, d/b/a The Big Easy Casino ("Big Easy Casino").
- 4. At all times material hereto, Big Easy Casino was a facility operated by a permitholder authorized to conduct pari-mutuel wagering and cardroom operations in the State of Florida.

- 5. On or about March 31, 2019, Respondent engaged in an act, practice, or course of operation with the intent of cheating a participant or the cardroom operator.
- 6. On or about April 18, 2019, Respondent was ejected and permanently excluded from Big Easy Casino.

COUNT I

- 7. Petitioner realleges and incorporates the allegations contained within paragraphs one through five as though fully set forth herein.
 - 8. Rule 61D-11.005(4), Florida Administrative Code, provides:
 - No person shall, either directly or indirectly: (a) Employ or attempt to employ any device, scheme, or artifice to defraud any participant in a game or the cardroom operator. (b) Engage in any act, practice, or course of operation that would constitute a fraud or deceit upon any participant in a game or the cardroom operator. (c) Engage in any act, practice, or course of operation with the intent of cheating any participant or the cardroom operator.
- 9. Based on the foregoing, Respondent violated Rule 61D-11.005(4), Florida Administrative Code, by engaging in an act, practice, or course of operation with the intent of cheating a participant or the cardroom operator at Big Easy Casino on or about March 31, 2019.

COUNT II

- 10. Petitioner realleges and incorporates the allegations contained within paragraphs one through four, and six as though fully set forth herein.
 - 11. Section 550.0251(6), Florida States, provides in relevant part:

In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any parimutuel facility in the state, the division may exclude any person from any and all pari-mutuel facilities in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this chapter or the rules of the division. The division may exclude from any pari-mutuel facility within this state any person who has been ejected from a pari-mutuel facility in this state or who has been excluded from any pari-mutuel facility in another state by the

governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over pari-mutuel facilities in such other state.

(Emphasis supplied).

12. Based on the foregoing, Respondent is subject to permanent exclusion from all licensed pari-mutuel facilities in the State of Florida based on his permanent exclusion from Big Easy Casino on or about April 18, 2019.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Division Director enter an Order permanently excluding Respondent from all licensed pari-mutuel and slot machine facilities in the State of Florida along with any other remedy provided by chapters 550 and 849, Florida Statutes, and/or the rules promulgated thereunder.
