#### FINAL ORDER

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering (hereinafter "Petitioner"), issues this Final Order against Dylan Persad, (hereinafter "Respondent") as follows:

- 1. An Administrative Complaint was filed in this case on May 15, 2020, alleging that Respondent violated sections 550.0251(6) and 551.112, Florida Statutes. A copy of the Administrative Complaint is attached hereto as Exhibit "1" and incorporated by reference.
- 2. The Administrative Complaint, Election of Rights form, an Explanation of Rights, and a cover letter were served on Respondent via Certified U.S. Mail on May 26, 2020. Proof of service is attached hereto as Exhibit "2" and incorporated by reference.
- 3. The Election of Rights form. Explanation of Rights, and cover letter informed Respondent that a written response to the Administrative Complaint, including the right to request a hearing, was due within 21 days of actual service of the Administrative Complaint. See section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, and Rule 78-106 111, Florida Administrative Code.

4. Petitioner informed Respondent that the failure to file a timely response to the

Administrative Complaint shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.

5. Respondent has not filed a timely response to the Administrative Complaint.

Respondent has not submitted any evidence or made any allegations that would support the

application of the doctrine of equitable tolling.

Having considered the Administrative Complaint, the evidence of Petitioner's reasonable

attempts to provide actual notice to Respondent, and being otherwise fully advised in the

premises, it is hereby

ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

6. The allegations of fact and the conclusions of law in the Administrative Complaint

are adopted in their entirety herein.

7. Respondent's Pari-Mutuel Wagering Slot Machine Professional Individual License,

number 11442753-1051, is hereby REVOKED

8. Respondent is hereby PERMANENTLY EXCLUDED from all licensed pari-mutuel

facilities in the State of Florida.

9. This Final Order is effective on the date it is filed with the Agency Clerk of the

Department of Business and Professional Regulation, as indicated on the first page of this Order.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT**

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering ("Petitioner"), files this Administrative Complaint against Dylan Persad ("Respondent"), and alleges:

- 1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating pari-mutuel wagering, slot machines, and cardroom operations pursuant to chapters 550, 551, and 849, Florida Statutes.
- 2. At all times material hereto, Respondent held a Pari-Mutuel Wagering Slot Machine Professional Employee Occupational License, number 11442753-1051, issued by Petitioner.
- 3. At all times material hereto, Calder Race Course, Inc. ("Calder") was a facility operated by a permitholder authorized to conduct pari-mutuel wagering, slot machines, and cardroom operations in the State of Florida.
- 4. On or about January 9, 2020, Respondent was ejected and permanently excluded from Calder.

5. Section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes, provides in relevant part:

In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any parimutuel facility in the state, the division may exclude any person from any and all pari-mutuel facilities in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this chapter or the rules of the division. The division may exclude from any pari-mutuel facility within this state any person who has been ejected from a pari-mutuel facility in this state or who has been excluded from any pari-mutuel facility in another state by the governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over pari-mutuel facilities in such other state.

6. Section 551.112, Florida Statutes, provides:

In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any facility of a slot machine licensee in this state, the division may exclude any person from any facility of a slot machine licensee in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this chapter or the rules of the division. The division may exclude from any facility of a slot machine licensee any person who has been ejected from a facility of a slot machine licensee in this state or who has been excluded from any facility of a slot machine licensee or gaming facility in another state by the governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over the gaming in such other state. This section does not abrogate the common law right of a slot machine licensee to exclude a patron absolutely in this state.

- 7. Section 551.103(4)(b)(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the division may "[d]eny, revoke, suspend, or place conditions on the license of a person who violates any provision of this chapter or rule adopted pursuant thereto."
- 8. Based on the foregoing, Respondent violated Section 550.0251(6) and 551.112, Florida Statutes, and is subject to permanent exclusion from all licensed pari-mutuel wagering facilities and any facility of a slot machine licensee in the State of Florida for his exclusion from Calder on January 9, 2020.

9. Further, under Section 551.103(4)(b)(2), Florida Statutes, due to Respondent's violation of Section 551.112, Florida Statutes, Respondent is subject to the revocation of the Pari-Mutuel Wagering Slot Machine Professional Employee Occupational License held by Respondent.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Division Director enter an Order imposing against Respondent one or more of the penalties specified by chapters 550 and 551, Florida Statutes, and/or the rules promulgated thereunder.

Mediation under section 120.573, Florida Statutes, is not available to resolve this Administrative Complaint.


