FINAL ORDER

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering ("Petitioner"), issues this Final Order against Andres Felipe Vacca ("Respondent") as follows:

- 1. An Administrative Complaint was filed in this case on May 4, 2020, alleging that Respondent violated Rule 61D-11.005(4), *Florida Administrative Code*, and section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes. A copy of the Administrative Complaint is attached hereto as Exhibit "1."
- 2. The Administrative Complaint, Election of Rights form, an Explanation of Rights, and a cover letter were served on Respondent via certified U.S. mail on May 15, 2020. Proof of service is attached hereto as Exhibit "2."
- 3. The Election of Rights form, Explanation of Rights, and cover letter informed Respondent that a written response to the Administrative Complaint, including the right to request a hearing, was due within 21 days of actual service of the Administrative Complaint. See section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, and Rule 28-106.111, Florida Administrative Code.

4. Petitioner informed Respondent that the failure to file a timely response to the

Administrative Complaint shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.

5. Respondent has not filed a timely response to the Administrative Complaint.

Respondent has not submitted any evidence or made any allegations that would support the

application of the doctrine of equitable tolling.

Having considered the Administrative Complaint, the proof of service, and being otherwise

fully advised in the premises, it is hereby

ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

6. The allegations of fact and the conclusions of law in the Administrative Complaint

are adopted in their entirety herein.

7. Respondent's Pari-Mutuel Wagering Slot Machine Combo General License, number

10273256-1056, is hereby **REVOKED**.

8. Respondent is hereby PERMANENTLY EXCLUDED from all pari-mutuel

facilities within the State of Florida.

9. This Final Order is effective on the date it is filed with the Agency Clerk of the

Department of Business and Professional Regulation.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering ("Petitioner"), files this Administrative Complaint against Andres Felipe Vacca ("Respondent"), and alleges:

- 1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating pari-mutuel wagering, slot machines, and cardroom operations pursuant to chapters 550, 551, and 849, Florida Statutes.
- 2. At all times material hereto, Respondent held a Pari-Mutuel Wagering Slot Machine Combo General Individual License, number 10273256-1056, issued by Petitioner.
- 3. At all times material hereto, Hialeah Park Racing & Casino ("Hialeah Park") was a facility operated by a permitholder authorized to conduct pari-mutuel wagering, slot machines, and cardroom operations in the State of Florida.
- 4. On or about February 11, 2020, Respondent, an employee of Hialeah Park, knowingly and unlawfully removed \$42.00 in poker chips from the "pot" in one or more live poker games, with the intent to cheat the participants of the games.

EXHIBIT Constitution of the state of the sta

COUNT I

- 5. Petitioner realleges and incorporates the allegations contained within paragraphs one through four as though fully set forth herein.
 - 6. Rule 61D-11.005(4), Florida Administrative Code, provides:

No person shall, either directly or indirectly: (a) Employ or attempt to employ any device, scheme, or artifice to defraud any participant in a game or the cardroom operator. (b) Engage in any act, practice, or course of operation that would constitute a fraud or deceit upon any participant in a game or the cardroom operator. (c) Engage in any act, practice, or course of operation with the intent of cheating any participant or the cardroom operator.

7. Based on the foregoing, Respondent violated section Rule 61D-11.005(4), Florida Administrative Code, by engaging in an act, practice or course of operation with the intent of cheating participants in cardroom games by stealing chips in the amount of \$42.00 from poker pots while at Hialeah Park, on February 11, 2020.

COUNT II

- 8. Petitioner realleges and incorporates the allegations contained within paragraphs one through seven as though fully set forth herein.
 - 9. Section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes, provides in relevant part:

In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any parimutuel facility in the state, the division may exclude any person from any and all pari-mutuel facilities in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this chapter or the rules of the division. The division may exclude from any pari-mutuel facility within this state any person who has been ejected from a pari-mutuel facility in this state or who has been excluded from any pari-mutuel facility in another state by the governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over pari-mutuel facilities in such other state.

10. Based on the foregoing, Respondent violated section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes and is subject to permanent exclusion from all licensed pari-mutuel wagering facilities in the State of Florida based on his violation of Rule 61D-11.005(4), Florida Statutes by engaging in an act, practice or course of operation with the intent of cheating participants in cardroom games by stealing chips in the amount of \$42.00 while at Hialeah Park, on February 11, 2020.

COUNT III

- 11. Petitioner realleges and incorporates the allegations contained within paragraphs one through four as though fully set forth herein.
 - 12. On or about February 14, 2020, Respondent was excluded from Hialeah Park.
 - 13. Section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes, provides in relevant part:
 - In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any parimutuel facility in the state, the division may exclude any person from any and all pari-mutuel facilities in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this chapter or the rules of the division. The division may exclude from any pari-mutuel facility within this state any person who has been ejected from a pari-mutuel facility in this state or who has been excluded from any pari-mutuel facility in another state by the governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over pari-mutuel facilities in such other state.
- 14. Based on the foregoing, under section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes, Respondent is subject to permanent exclusion from all licensed pari-mutuel wagering facilities in the State of Florida based on his exclusion from Hialeah Park on February 14, 2020.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Division Director enter an Order permanently excluding Respondent from all licensed pari-mutuel wagering facilities in the State of Florida, along with any other remedy provided by chapter 550, Florida Statutes, and/or the rules promulgated thereunder.



Pursuant to Rule 28-106.111, Florida Administrative Code, you must request a hearing within 21 days from receipt of this Notice, or you will waive your right to request a hearing.

Mediation under section 120.573, Florida Statutes, is not available to resolve this Administrative Complaint.
