FINAL ORDER

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering (hereinafter "Petitioner"), issues this Final Order against Jarius Radcliff, (hereinafter "Respondent") as follows:

- 1. An Administrative Complaint was filed in this case on October 26, 2020, alleging that Respondent violated section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes. A copy of the Administrative Complaint is attached hereto as Exhibit "1" and incorporated by reference.
- 2. The Administrative Complaint, Election of Rights form, an Explanation of Rights, and a cover letter were served on Respondent via certified U.S. mail on November 2, 2020. Proof of service is attached hereto as Exhibit "2" and incorporated by reference.
- 3. The Election of Rights form, Explanation of Rights, and cover letter informed Respondent that a written response to the Administrative Complaint, including the right to request a hearing, was due within 21 days of actual service of the Administrative Complaint. See section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, and Rule 28-106.111, Florida Administrative Code.

4. Petitioner informed Respondent that the failure to file a timely response to the

Administrative Complaint shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.

5. Respondent has not filed a timely response to the Administrative Complaint.

Respondent has not submitted any evidence or made any allegations that would support the

application of the doctrine of equitable tolling.

Having considered the Administrative Complaint, the service of the Administrative

Complaints with Election of Rights forms, Explanation of Rights, and cover letters on

Respondent along with Respondent's failure to respond, and being otherwise fully advised in the

premises, it is hereby

ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

6. The allegations of fact and the conclusions of law in the Administrative Complaint

are adopted in their entirety herein.

7. Respondent is hereby **PERMANENTLY EXCLUDED** from all pari-mutuel

facilities within the state of Florida.

8. This Final Order is effective on the date it is filed with the Agency Clerk of the

Department of Business and Professional Regulation, as indicated on the first page of this Order.



ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering ("Petitioner"), files this Administrative Complaint against Jarius Radcliff ("Respondent"), and alleges:

- 1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating pari-mutuel wagering, slot machines, and cardroom operations pursuant to chapters 550 and 551, Florida Statutes.
- 2. At all times material hereto, Respondent's address was reported as 439 N. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard, Daytona Beach, Florida 32114.
- 3. At all times material hereto, Daytona Beach Kennel Club, Inc., d/b/a Daytona Beach Racing and Card Club and/or Daytona Beach Kennel Club and Poker Room ("Daytona Beach Kennel Club") is a facility operated by a permitholder authorized to conduct pari-mutuel wagering and cardroom operations in the State of Florida.
- 4. At all times material hereto, West Volusia Racing, Inc., d/b/a Orange City Racing and Card Club ("West Volusia Racing") is a facility operated by a permitholder authorized to



conduct pari-mutuel wagering, greyhound racing, and cardroom operations in the State of Florida.

- 5. On or about August 21, 2020, Respondent was ejected and excluded from Daytona Beach Kennel Club.
- 6. On or about August 21, 2020, Respondent was ejected and excluded from West Volusia Racing.
 - 7. Section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes, provides in relevant part:

In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any parimutuel facility in the state, the division may exclude any person from any and all pari-mutuel facilities in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this chapter or the rules of the division. The division may exclude from any pari-mutuel facility within this state any person who has been ejected from a pari-mutuel facility in this state or who has been excluded from any pari-mutuel facility in another state by the governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over pari-mutuel facilities in such other state.

(Emphasis supplied).

COUNT I

- 8. Petitioner re-alleges and incorporates the allegations contained within paragraphs one through seven as though fully set forth herein.
- 9. Based on the foregoing, Respondent was ejected and excluded from Daytona Beach Kennel Club on or about August 21, 2020 and is subject to permanent exclusion from all licensed pari-mutuel wagering facilities in the State of Florida.

COUNT II

10. Petitioner re-alleges and incorporates the allegations contained within paragraphs one through seven as though fully set forth herein.

11. Based on the foregoing, Respondent was ejected and excluded from West Volusia Racing on or about August 21, 2020 and is subject to permanent exclusion from all licensed pari-mutuel wagering facilities in the State of Florida.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Division Director enter an Order permanently excluding Respondent from all licensed pari-mutuel facilities in the State of Florida, along with any other remedy provided by chapters 550 and 551, Florida Statutes, and/or the rules promulgated thereunder.

Mediation under section 120.573, Florida Statutes, is not available to resolve this Administrative Complaint.
