FINAL ORDER

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering ("Petitioner" or "Division"), issues this Final Order against Kevin Passee ("Respondent") as follows:

- 1. An Administrative Complaint was filed in this case on March 4, 2021, alleging that Respondent violated Section 550.2415(6)(d), and 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes. A true and correct copy of the Administrative Complaint is attached hereto as Exhibit "1" and incorporated by reference.
- 2. Service of the Administrative Complaint, Election of Rights form, an Explanation of Rights, and a cover letter was attempted on Respondent via certified U.S. mail, sent out on March 5, 2021 and May 10, 2021. Proofs of attempted service via certified mail is attached hereto as Exhibit "2" and incorporated by reference.
- 3. Notice of this matter was served upon Respondent on June 17, 2021, June 24, 2021, July 1, 2021, and July 8, 2021, via publication in the *Voice of South Marion*, a publication

in general circulation within Marion County, Florida ("Notice of Action"). A true and correct copy of the Notice of Action is attached hereto as Exhibit "3" and incorporated by reference.

- 4. The Notice of Action informed Respondent that Petitioner filed an Administrative Complaint against them, provided instructions on how to receive a copy of the Administrative Complaint, and that contact would be required to dispute the allegations within the Administrative Complaint. See Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes and Rule 28-106.111, Florida Administrative Code.
- 5. In addition, the Notice of Action informed Respondent that the failure to timely file a response to the Administrative Complaint would be deemed a waiver of right to a hearing or resolution in this matter.
- 6. To date, Respondent has not provided a response to the Administrative Complaint filed and served in this action.

Having considered the Administrative Complaint, the service of the Administrative Complaint with Election of Rights form, Explanation of Rights, and cover letter on Respondent along with Respondent's failure to respond, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is hereby

ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

- 7. The allegations of fact and the conclusions of law in the Administrative Complaint are adopted in their entirety herein.
- 8. Respondent's Pari-Mutuel Wagering Professional Individual Occupational License, number 6710235-1021, is hereby **REVOKED**.
- 9. Respondent is hereby **PERMANENTLY EXCLUDED** from all pari-mutuel facilities in the State of Florida.


ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering ("Petitioner"), files this Administrative Complaint against Kevin Passee ("Respondent"), and alleges:

- 1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating pari-mutuel wagering pursuant to chapter 550, Florida Statutes.
- 2. At all times material hereto, Respondent held a Pari-Mutuel Wagering Professional Individual Occupational License, number 6710235-1021, issued by Petitioner.
- 3. At all times material hereto, Tampa Bay Downs, Inc. ("TBD"), was a facility operated by a permitholder authorized to conduct pari-mutuel wagering in this state under chapter 550, Florida Statutes.

COUNT 1

4. Petitioner realleges and incorporates the allegations contained within paragraphs one through three as though fully set forth herein.



- 5. At all times material hereto, the racehorse "Annie" with tattoo number S21694 was a racehorse that participated in races on which pari-mutuel wagering is conducted in this state.
- 6. On or about December 19, 2020, Respondent unjustifiably and unnecessarily tormented the racehorse "Annie", by repeatedly beating her while on the grounds of TBD.
 - 7. Respondent's cruelty was not done in the interest of medical science.
- 8. Section 550.2415(6)(a), Florida Statutes, provides "[i]t is the intent of the Legislature that animals that participate in races in this state on which pari-mutuel wagering is conducted and animals that are bred and trained in this state for racing be treated humanely, both on and off racetracks, throughout the lives of the animals."
 - 9. Further, Section 550.2415(6)(d), Florida Statutes states:

Any act committed by any licensee that would constitute cruelty to animals as defined in s. 828.02 involving any animal constitutes a violation of this chapter. Imposition of any penalty by the division for violation of this chapter or any rule adopted by the division pursuant to this chapter shall not prohibit a criminal prosecution for cruelty to animals.

10. Based on the foregoing, Respondent is in violation of Section 550.2415(6), Florida Statutes, for committing an act that constitutes animal cruelty.

COUNT II

- 11. Petitioner realleges and incorporates the allegations contained within paragraphs one through three as though fully set forth herein.
 - 12. On or about December 19, 2020, Respondent was ejected from TBD.
 - 13. Section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes, provides in relevant part:

In addition to the power to exclude certain persons from any parimutuel facility in the state, the division may exclude any person from any and all pari-mutuel facilities in this state for conduct that would constitute, if the person were a licensee, a violation of this

chapter or the rules of the division. The division may exclude from any pari-mutuel facility within this state any person who has been ejected from a pari-mutuel facility in this state or who has been excluded from any pari-mutuel facility in another state by the governmental department, agency, commission, or authority exercising regulatory jurisdiction over pari-mutuel facilities in such other state.

(Emphasis supplied).

14. Based on the foregoing, Respondent violated section 550.0251(6), Florida Statutes, and is subject to exclusion from all licensed pari-mutuel wagering facilities in the State of Florida based on his ejection from TBD.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Division Director enter an Order imposing against Respondent one or more of the penalties the Division is authorized to impose pursuant to chapter 550, Florida Statutes, and/or the rules promulgated thereunder.




