Where the value of the unclaimed tickets escheat to the State or Breeders' Association, any excess of the cashes over the purchases shall be remitted to the State or Breeders' Association. Adjustments to the end of meet outs balance should be handwritten on the tote produced outs report for the last day of the meet and a copy attached to this form. If the outsbook is produced on the last day, and the tote buys are cashed manually after the outsbook is printed, adjust the total on the last page of the outsbook.

The totalisator malfunction log and the list(s) of purchased tickets must be available to the Division representatives upon request. Purchases not supported with the log and the list of purchased tickets will be disallowed. The totalisator produced report of tote cashes should be attached. Tote cashes must be processed on either the last day of the meet, or the day the outsbook is printed.

Only the summaries affecting the DBPR PMW-3510, Report of Escheated Outs, will be mailed to the Division (this is limited to live wagering only), within 30 days of the end of the live meet.
